Minutes of the AVP Indiana Annual Gathering July 20, 2019 Peace Learning Center, Indianapolis, Indiana

Report by Archer Bunner: The AVP/USA Gathering in Oakland, California was successful. Six RHS Students attended the Gathering as well as twelve from the AVP Indiana circle. J.T. shared his happiness for the support one of the differently-sighted students received from the rest of the group. The RHS student-led breakout session was in the AVP workshop mode – participants had many positive comments on the students' preparation. The goal is to have youth as at least 25% of Gathering attendees. The conversation concerning under-18 students being around returned citizens whose crimes are not known or tracked by AVP/USA continues to evolve.

Approval of officers: Erica Pearson requested stepping back from being one of the cocoordinators, citing her preparation for retirement. The motion for renewing Archer Bunner, Miriam Bunner and Aaron Nell as co-coordinators was approved. Archer Bunner and Miriam Bunner were also approved for continuing as Co-Treasurers.

Treasurers report: See Budget document. AVP Indiana uses the cash accounting method - accounting for expenses when they are paid and when deposits are put in the bank. The Budget represents 3 years of data. Highlights: expected surplus for next year, income from honorariums and in-kind donations, copy arrangement with ESR. Mike suggested creating a set mileage reimbursement as opposed to a pump receipt. AVP USA reimburses for 25 cents per mile (above the 14 cents for non-profits). No action was taken. Most of the expenses included the AVP USA Annual Gathering and the procurement of Manuals. The Budget was approved.
